

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Fourth St from Technology Pl to Archer St is now open. 84-inch pipe installation, paving, and striping is complete. New signage is being placed to clarify traffic configuration.

Fourth St from Archer St to Gish Rd is closed until early September for 84-inch pipe installation, temporary sewer bypass, utilities connections, and dewatering well construction.

Fourth St and Gish intersection remains open until mid-September. Closure anticipated from mid-September through the end of October.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Southbound lane closure. Northbound lane will remain open.
- Traffic control will be in place.
- Intermittent intersection closures
- At least one driveway access will be maintained for each property.
- Detours will be in place to route drivers around the area of work.
- No Parking signs will be posted and parking will be restricted.
- Temporary sewer service interruptions, which will be coordinated with affected services ahead of time.

The San Jose Fourth St Sewer Project was granted an exemption from the Santa Clara County shelter-in-place order because public works construction is considered “Essential Infrastructure” under section 10.c.

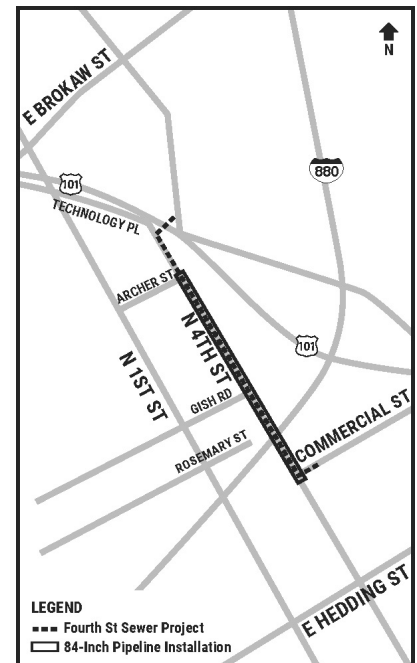
