

FOURTH ST SEWER PROJECT

FACT SHEET | FEBRUARY 2021

GNAI

To improve the capacity of the City's sewage system.

HNW

By replacing 48-in and 54-in diameter sanitary sewer pipes with 4,500 ft of 84-in diameter pipes and approximately 300 ft of 72-in diameter pipes.

WHERE

Along N Fourth St between US Highway 101 (US 101) and E Hedding St and along Commercial St between Fourth St and Fifth St, fronting residences and businesses.


WHFN

Construction began in August 2019 and is anticipated to continue through Fall 2021.

PROJECT DETAILS

Infrastructure changes will convey sewage from Commercial St to Old Bayshore Rd north of US 101 and the installation of a small diameter local collector sanitary sewer system. Existing junction structures will need to be modified and new ones built in order to accommodate the new pipes. Sewage rerouting and diversion will be required throughout construction to maintain service.



KEYS TO PROJECT SUCCESS

- Thorough community outreach
- Complex traffic management

FUTURE IMPACTS

- Shutdown of ¼ City interceptors for maintenance/repair
- Traffic will be temporarily impacted during construction along N Fourth St

HIGHLIGHTS

The project will cross under US 101, Interstate 880, several large storm pipes and existing utilities, and require Caltrans permits to perform work within Caltrans right of way.
